

South Florida Youth Soccer Club Wins Prestigious DANONE Nations Cup Qualifier at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex at Disney

Disney victory earns Weston FC spot at world's biggest 12-under youth soccer tournament in October; Weston FC to take on elite youth teams from 32 participating countries in Morocco

It took quite a feat for Weston FC to qualify for the trip to Morocco. The team first had to conquer the field at the Disney Memorial Day Soccer Shootout, the**largest three-day soccer tournament held at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex. The event** attracts more than 600 teams to Disney during Memorial Day Weekend.
