

Baseball Legend Cal Ripken Jr. Narrates Candlelight Processional

Cal Ripken Jr. may be best known for the legendary things he did during his 21 seasons in Major League Baseball with the Baltimore Orioles, but this holiday season, the Hall-of-Famer showed he's just as capable narrating a story as he is being the focus of one.

From Dec. 28-30, Ripken Jr. joined the ranks of celebrities who have lended their voices to narrate the Candlelight Processional at the American Gardens Theatre at Epcot. Each winter, Holidays Around the World transforms Epcot into an international celebration replete with festive decorations and live entertainment.
