

Julian Edelman, Malcolm Butler of the Patriots Celebrate Super Bowl Win with Victory Parade at Disneyland

ANAHEIM, Calif. (February 2, 2015) -Just hours after shouting the iconic phrase, "I'm going to Disneyland!" Julian Edelman and Malcolm Butler flew to the Disneyland Resort in Southern California to celebrate their team's Super Bowl win. Park guests cheered as they cruised down Main Street U.S.A. in a ticker tape victory parade with Mickey Mouse.
