

More Than 40,000 Participants Competing in 45th Annual AAU Girls' Junior National Volleyball Championships

The AAU Girls Junior National Volleyball Championships, arguably the world's largest volleyball tournament, is taking place at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex through June 28.

This year, the event is expected to draw more than 40,000 athletes and 600 collegiate volleyball coaches as the top prep volleyball players in the nation compete for national titles in various divisions.
