

Central Florida and Tampa Bay Area Teams Headline Disney Cross Country Classic this Weekend at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex at Walt Disney World Resort



Top men's and women's collegiate teams from Central Florida and the Tampa area headline the Disney Cross Country Classic this weekend at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex at Walt Disney World Resort.

Rollins College (Orlando) and Florida College (Tampa) are among the 267 teams competing in the event, which features more than 3,500 runners from Alabama, California, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, New York, Ohio, South Carolina, Texas and Virginia.

In the high school division, boys' and girls' high school teams from Orangewood Christian School (Maitland) and St. Petersburg High School (St. Petersburg) round out the field of top area teams.
