

The Miami Heat and the Los Angeles Lakers Will Face Off in the 2020 NBA Finals at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex

LAKE BUENA VISTA, Fla., (Sept. 28, 2020) – The 2020 NBA Finals tip off this Wednesday, Sept. 30 at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex at Walt Disney World Resort in Florida.
